

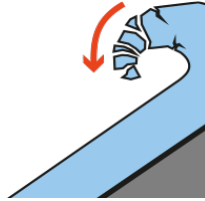

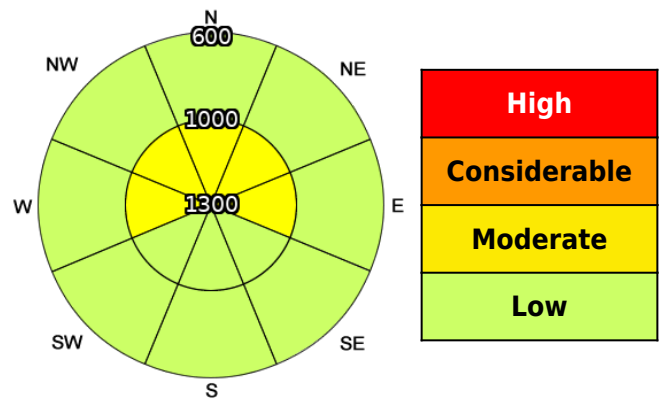
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of moderately well bonded windslab will continue to develop on West through North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Areas most affected will be steep wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and coire rims. Fragile cornices above these aspects. Elsewhere the snowpack will continue to consolidate and stabilise. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-Easterly winds will ease to become fresh and Southerly during the day. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres with overnight snowfall expected to ease with some lighter snow showers during the morning.

Comments

Lower slopes softened and thawed slightly in the milder temperatures, paths remained hard and icy in places.
