




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated and generally shallow accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will persist, mainly at tops of gullies and around corrie rims on North through East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres. Small but fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. The older snowpack will be generally stable in all locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain generally dry with light East-North-Easterly winds. After an overnight frost, the freezing level will be around 800 metres.
