

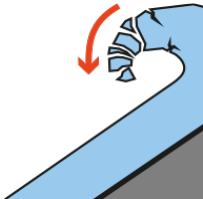

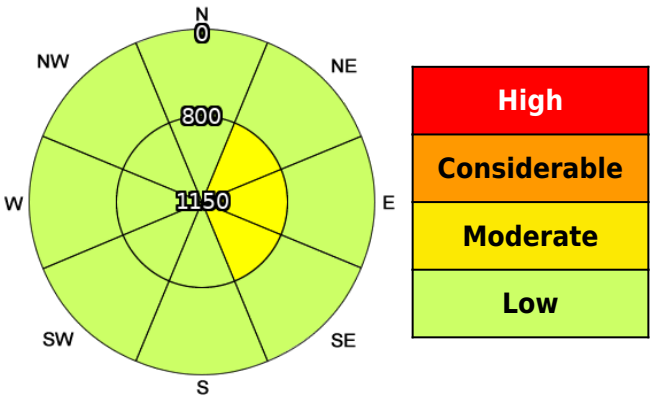
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will remain firm and icy with generally good stability. New snow and South-Westerly winds will form areas of windslab in wind sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations are expected in wind sheltered summit gully exits and on steep scarp slopes with a North-Easterly to South-East aspect mainly above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will form above these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold freezing at most levels. New snow overnight and on Tuesday will affect the area. Winds will be moderate to fresh generally South-Westerly.

Comments

Widespread icing exists on exposed slopes and in watercourses with some unforgiving consequences. New snow expected overnight and on Tuesday but amounts and timing are uncertain.
