

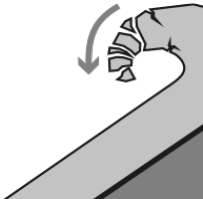

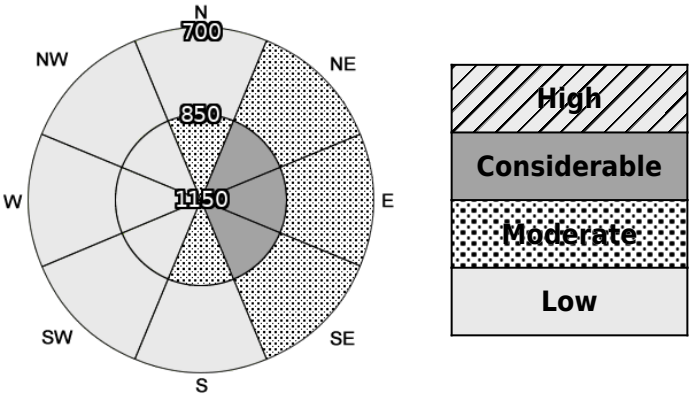

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab accumulations will continue to develop with greatest accumulations on steep North-East to South-East aspects mostly above 850 metres. Localised deposits present on North and South aspects and at lower elevations. Terrain features most affected will be wind sheltered locations such as gullies and coire back walls. Fragile cornices will continue to develop above all these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing cold with snow at all levels during the evening, which will clear during the night to give a dry morning with further snow developing during the afternoon. Fresh mainly Westerly winds. Freezing at all levels.

Comments

Some uncertainty in snowfall amounts. Remaining cold till the weekend.
