

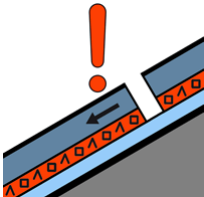

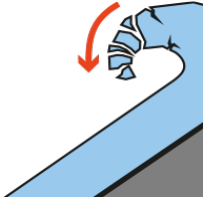

Wind Slab



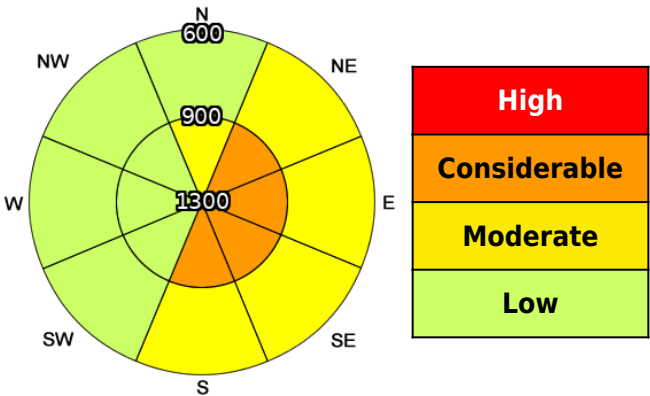
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing soft surface layers of the snowpack will be redistributed by the wind to form areas of unstable windslab. These areas are not expected to be particularly extensive, but will be poorly bonded. Most affected will be North-East through East to South aspects above 900 meters. Fragile cornices will be present on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh to strong winds will be from the West or North-West. After small amounts of overnight snow, it will be a generally dry day. Temperatures will remain below freezing at all levels.

Comments

Continuing cold conditions, significant redistribution of recent snowfall expected when winds increase.
