

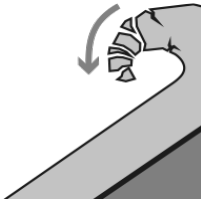

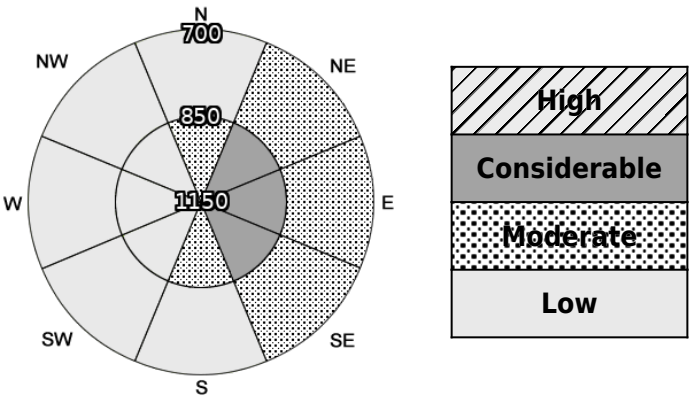
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution, further snow and cold temperatures will cause very unstable windslab to continue to develop on steep North-East to South-East aspects, mostly above 850 metres. More localised poorly bonded deposits will also be present on North and South aspects. Terrain most affected will be wind sheltered locations such as gullies and coire back walls. Fragile cornices will be present above all these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing very cold with snow showers throughout the day. Fresh Northerly winds will back Westerly and increase in strength during the afternoon. Freezing at all levels with a midday summit temperature on Bidean nam Bian of - 9 degrees Celsius.

Comments

Some uncertainty in snowfall amounts. Further snowfall on Friday with a much warmer day on Saturday.
