




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations on mainly North-East through East to South aspects above 850 metres, where avalanches are likely. North and South-West aspects will also be affected due to variable wind directions. Cornices will be prone to collapse. Areas exposed to the wind will remain firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry overnight, except for a few isolated showers this evening. Throughout the day there will be regular snow showers. Moderate winds from variable North-Westerly directions overnight. Strong West-North-West winds during the day. The freezing level will remain below 200 metres throughout the period.
