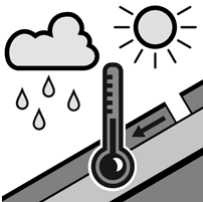


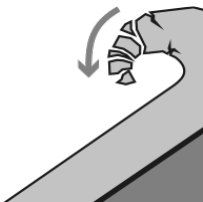

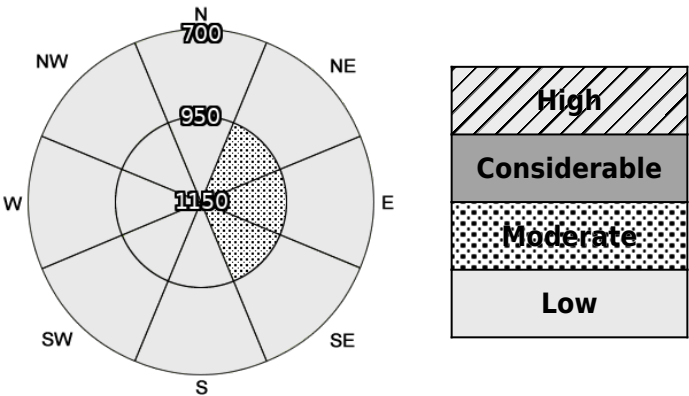
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight, the existing snowpack, will continue to slowly consolidate. During the day, there may be some wet instabilities on very steep North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Other aspects will be stable at all altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight, then rain at all levels from late morning onwards. South-East to South-Westerly winds will be fresh overnight, becoming very strong to gale force during the day. Freezing levels will rise to well above the summits during the day.

Comments

Another cycle of fluctuation temperatures, rain tomorrow afternoon will lead to some further snow loss. There still remains decent snow cover above 800 metres on North to East aspects.
