



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 28/01/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will be wet but stable. Greatest accumulations will be on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Any lingering cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits throughout the forecast period. Overnight winds will be storm force South-South-Westerly and increase yet further in ferocity during the morning. After a few showers of rain during the evening it will be dry until the afternoon when precipitation will resume turning to sleet on the highest summits by the end of the day.

Comments

A cooler and drier day with much lighter winds anticipated for Monday. Burn crossings are currently hazardous and paths more like stream beds.
