




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wet snow instabilities will be present on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 1150 metres. Gully tops and coire rims will be most affected. At lower elevations the snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate and stability will be generally good. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild conditions with the freezing level above the summits. Precipitation will be rain at all levels, this will become heavy in the afternoon. Storm force Southerly winds.
