



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 29/01/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Much colder conditions will start to refreeze the wet snowpack with firm surface layers developing. The remaining snow will be well bonded and stable throughout. Patchy snow below 900 metres. Deeper amounts in high North to East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation overnight or through the day. Gale force South-South-Westerly winds will ease overnight and veer to become moderate to light Northerlies by midday. The freezing level will lower to 550 metres overnight, settling around 700 metres during the day.

Comments

Wet, thawing snow will eventually refreeze at higher elevations becoming firm and icy.
