



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 01/02/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will be firm and generally well bonded. The greatest accumulations remain in North to East facing corries above 900 metres. A dusting of new snow is expected on the highest summits, this will not be significant in depth. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force and generally Westerly winds overnight will decrease slightly in strength during the day. The freezing level will be around 600 metres overnight, rising to reach summit levels by late afternoon. A dry morning with trace amounts of new snow on the highest summits during the afternoon.
