



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 01/02/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain firm and stable. Some fresh deposits are expected on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. However, these are expected to be isolated, shallow and avoidable. Exposed windward slopes will hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few snow showers are expected overnight and through the day. Gale force winds will be from the West. The freezing level will be around 600 metres during the night, rising slowly to around 900 metres during the day.

Comments

A band of snow turning to rain is expected to reach the area on Thursday evening just after the end of the forecast period.
