

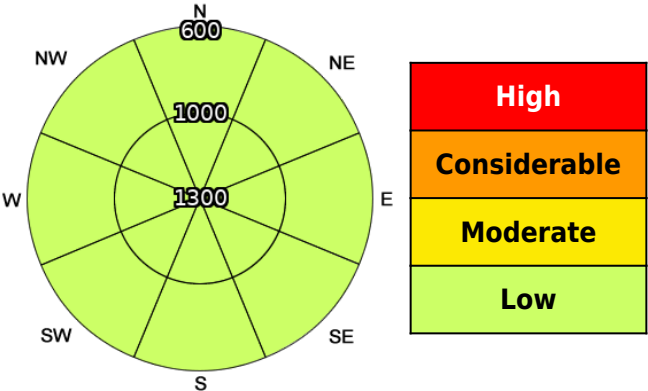

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 03/02/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be well bonded and stable throughout, becoming firm at all altitudes. Greatest snow cover will remain above 900 metres in coire back walls, shallow gullies and on high plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mainly dry day is expected with gale to storm force Westerly winds. The freezing level will initially be well above the summits, then drop steadily through the night to around 700 metres where it will remain during the day.

Comments

Snowpack will become firm and icy, with run outs having serious consequences.
