
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated and shallow accumulations of fresh unstable windslab will develop mainly on North-East and East aspects above 900 metres with corrie rims, ridge flanks and gully tops most affected. The older snowpack will become firm as the temperature drops and will remain stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force West-South-Westerly winds. Showers will initially fall as rain but will turn to snow above 700 metres during the day. The freezing level will drop to around 800 metres during the day.
