
##### Avalanche Problems

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The vast majority of the snow will be well bonded. Unstable windslab will start to form in wind sheltered locations on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. New deposits will be mostly shallow and avoidable but there is the possibility of deeper accumulations forming on the higher mountains along the Northern boundary of the forecast area. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Light precipitation falling as snow during the morning above 800 metres, but after midday, only above 1000 metres. Severe gale force Westerly winds overnight, gradually easing to near gale force by mid-morning. 900 metre freezing level overnight, rising to 1000 metres by early afternoon.
