



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 06/02/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow cover will steadily become firm and remain stable throughout. Most snow will be found above 950 metres on North and East aspects around coire rims, gully lines and on high plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent rain will clear through the evening, leaving a mainly dry day with occasional light showers, falling as snow above 400 metres. The freezing level will fall steadily from being well above the summits to around 600 metres by early hours, where it will remain. Very strong Westerly winds.

Comments

Significant snow loss at all levels today, but set to return to colder temperatures tomorrow. Runs out will have serious consequences as the snow cover becomes firm.
