

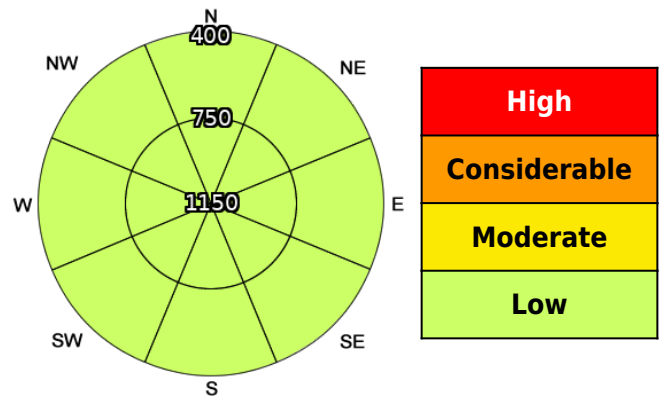

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 09/02/2024**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Isolated accumulations of redistributed snow will form in wind sheltered locations on Westerly aspects above 750 metres, however, amounts are not expected to be significant and will mostly lie on bare ground. Areas exposed to the wind will be scoured and frozen. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain mainly dry with gale to storm force Easterly winds around the highest summits. Isolated snow flurries are possible throughout the day as the freezing level rises slightly to around 400 metres.
