
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moderately well bonded windslab, primarily on South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres will continue to gradually stabilise. Other aspects will be firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be dry with light South-Easterly winds. Around dawn there may be some light summit snow as the winds veer progressively to the West increasing to moderate during the afternoon. The freezing level will be around the summits throughout the forecast period.

Comments

Surprisingly quiet in the hills. One winter skills group and one lone skier to the East of ski centre. Definitely a turn to be had for the committed.
