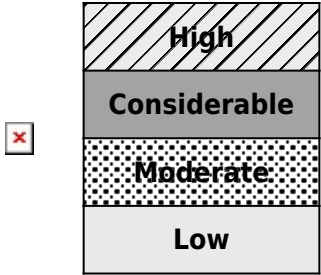
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present on North and North-East aspects above 900 metres with further accumulations being deposited during the afternoon also affecting East aspects. Isolated windslab remains on all Westerly aspects above 900 metres, lying mainly on bare ground and as such should not be significant. Elsewhere the stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mainly dry overnight and during the morning when the moderate South-Easterly winds slowly increase. During the afternoon snow showers are expected as the winds continue to freshen, and veer to become South-Westerly. The freezing level will remain around 1000 metres throughout the period, dropping slightly in the afternoon.
