### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 13/02/2024


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable accumulations will continue to develop on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered features such as scarp slopes, gully tops and corrie rims will be most affected with deposits only moderately bonded. Elsewhere, exposed locations will be scoured with deeper drifts found in lee locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Cold overnight with light snow showers to low levels. The freezing level will rise during the day to around 750 metres. Winds will be South-West to West-South-West throughout the period.

#### Comments

Very icy in places falls or trips could have serious consequences.
