

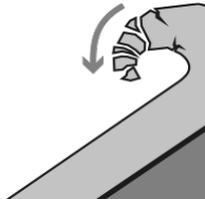



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly consolidate in the warmer temperatures but there will be a period of reduced stability during rainfall in the latter part of the night. Deeper accumulations of recent snow on North to East aspects above 800 metres will be most affected. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to well above the summits. There will be moderate to fresh South-Easterly winds. A dry evening, then rain overnight with showers during the day.
