



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/02/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow will continue to thaw but will remain generally well bonded. Later the afternoon will see shallow accumulations of snow developing in wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and corrie rims on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Distribution and depth of new accumulations will not be significant and be generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Initially the freezing level will remain above the summits with precipitation falling as rain. But it will become cooler mid-afternoon with a dusting of snow on the summits. Winds, moderate in strength, South-West to West during the day.

Comments

New snowfall is not expected to be significant.
