

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh unstable windslab will develop through the forecast period mainly on steep North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Wind sheltered areas such as coire rims and gullies will be most affected with accumulations gaining depth in these locations as the day progresses. Fragile cornices will begin to form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Showers throughout the period will be snow above 700 metres overnight turning to snow above 400 metres during the day as the freezing level falls to a similar level. Strong South-South Westerly winds overnight will ease slightly during the day and veer South-Westerly during the afternoon.

**Comments**

Some uncertainty in precipitation amounts due to showery nature of forecast snowfall.
