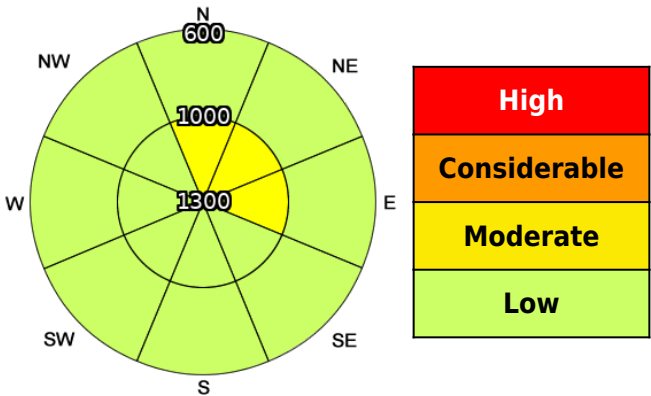
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will remain on North to East aspects above 1000 meters. Areas most affected will be steep wind sheltered locations such as corrie rims, gully exits and convexities. Elsewhere the remnants of old snow will be firm, icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate South-Westerly winds veering North-West by late afternoon. Light snow showers possible later in the day. The freezing level will be around 700 meters. Widespread frost at all levels overnight.

Comments

Little change is expected over the weekend. Light winds, predominantly dry with summit temperatures staying well below zero. Very icy underfoot conditions on the main tracks and serious run outs below the remnants of old snow.
