

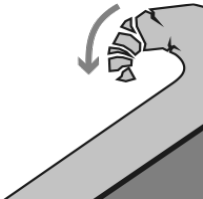

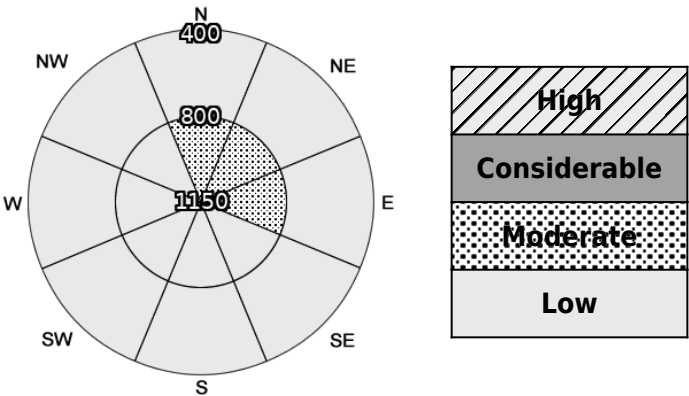
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Instabilities will persist in recent windslab accumulations mainly on steep North to East aspects above 800 metres, with isolated instabilities possible on North-West aspects. Areas most affected will be where deeper accumulations have developed in gullies, crag aprons and around coire rims. Fragile cornices will be present above these locations. Elsewhere there is a covering of soft but generally stable snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry cloudy day with light mainly Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 750 metres.
