



Wind Slab




Cornices

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be present, mainly on steep North to East aspects above 900 metres. Scarp slopes, gully tops and coire rims will be most affected. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. In general, South to West aspects will be scoured and stable.

The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the period with some cloud. Freezing level will slowly rise to around 600-700 metres during the day. Winds will be light and back from the East to North-East.

#### Comments

Another dry and fine day is forecast for tomorrow with light winds. Trailbreaking is currently hard work in the soft unconsolidated snow, particularly where it lies on bare ground.
