



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cold conditions overnight and through the day will maintain a generally stable snowpack. The surface of the snow will be firm and icy in many exposed locations. It will remain dry throughout. Isolated soft snow patches and cornices will require care and attention. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong to gale Easterly winds will continue to affect the area. It will remain cold and dry. Summit temperatures will be around -3 to -5 degrees Celsius.

Comments

Remaining dry and cool, exposed slopes icy with serious run out potential in the event of an uncontrolled slip or fall.
