

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 19/03/2024


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The wet snow cover will initially continue to thaw at all levels with isolated wet snow instabilities possible on very steep terrain. Any remaining cornices will be unstable. Snow cover is expected to become firmer above 1000 metres as the freezing level lowers in the afternoon. Greatest amounts will be found on West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above the summits overnight but lower to around 1000 metres by the end of the day. Rain is expected overnight followed by a dry day. Strong winds from the South overnight, veering and easing to become fresh West-North-Westerlies by afternoon.
