

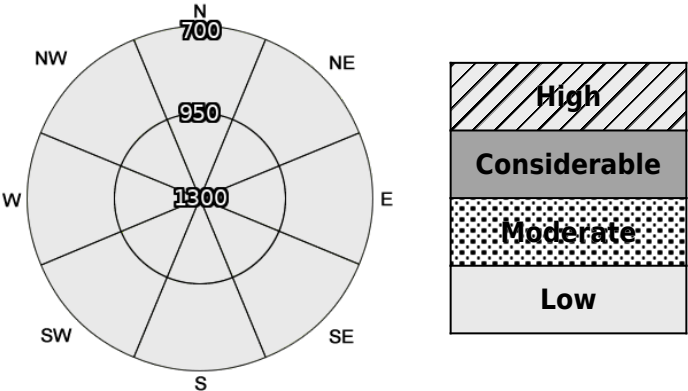

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 20/03/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate. Stability will be generally good. The greatest cover will be mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres. Small and isolated areas of new snow will be present above 800 metres, though amounts are not expected to be significant. Elsewhere, the cover is patchy and restricted to stream beds and hollows. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, moderate South-Easterly winds will back Northerly and become light during the day. Light snow during the morning. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.

Comments

Firm snow ice expected on many slopes. Serious consequences in the event of a slip or trip.
