

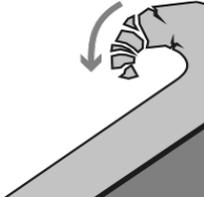


Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will persist, mainly on steep shady North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Fragile cornices will remain, mainly above these aspects. Any fresh windslab accumulations are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to fresh East-North-Easterly winds. Light snow showers in the evening followed by a mainly dry day. The freezing level will drop to around 500 metres overnight and rise to 800 metres during the day.

Comments

The older snowpack will remain frozen and very firm.
