
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly consolidate. However, some areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain, particularly where the more recent deposits overlie the old firm icy snowpack. These areas will tend to be on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. On other aspects the snowpack will be shallower, and stability will be better. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cloudy with some light snow showers possible. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres. Easterly winds overnight will ease, and strengthen again from the South-West during the day.
