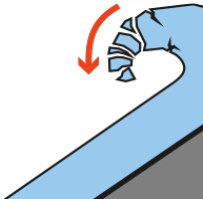

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 04/04/2024

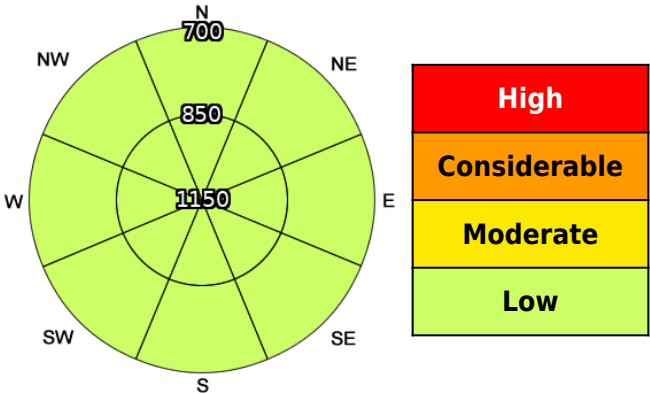
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

General snowpack stability will remain good in most areas. Isolated pockets of windslab may exist on the very steepest slopes around corrie rims and gully exits, these will generally be shallow and avoidable. Cornices will be suspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry conditions are expected overnight and on Thursday. Winds will be generally Easterly, fresh becoming moderate. The freezing level will be around 600 metres in the morning rising to 950 metres through the day.

Comments

Dry and cool conditions expected. The snowpack will be firm on some exposed slopes at higher levels. In many other areas a breakable melt freeze crust will exist.
