
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will continue to consolidate becoming soft in nature. Some minor surface instabilities will be found in the very steepest of locations on South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres but generally stability will be good. Greatest accumulations will be found above 800 metres on North through East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain to all levels with varying degrees of intensity although slightly drier in the afternoon. Easterly winds, veering Southerly increasing to storm force around dawn. Freezing level well above the summits.

Comments

Thaw conditions. Significant snow loss expected, especially where accumulations are shallow.
