

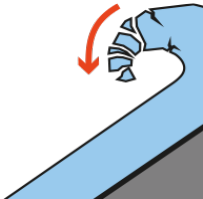

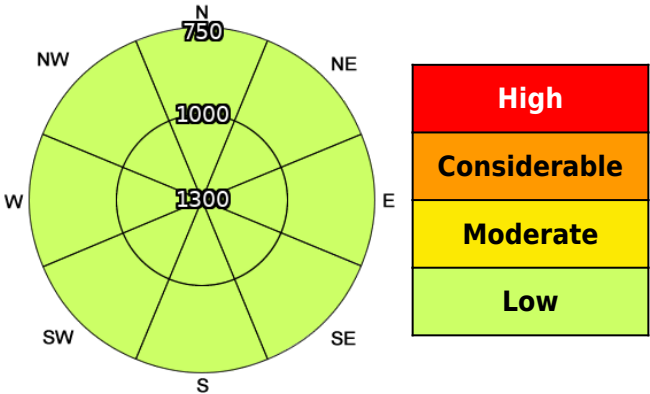

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the old snowpack will consolidate and become more stable. New unstable windslab will develop on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. These accumulations are expected to be shallow, isolated, generally avoidable and confined to steep, wind sheltered locations such as coire rims and gully exits. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

From the middle of the night onwards snow showers are expected above 1000 to 1100 metres on storm force South-South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fluctuate between 1100 metres and summit levels.

Comments

New accumulations of windslab expected to be confined to the most wind sheltered locations. Snow often ablated into the atmosphere during storm force winds.
