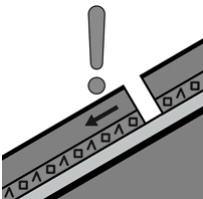


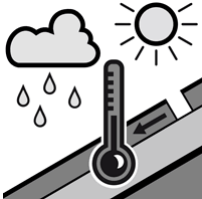

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 11/04/2024

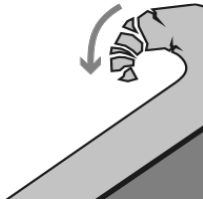

Persistent Weak Layers



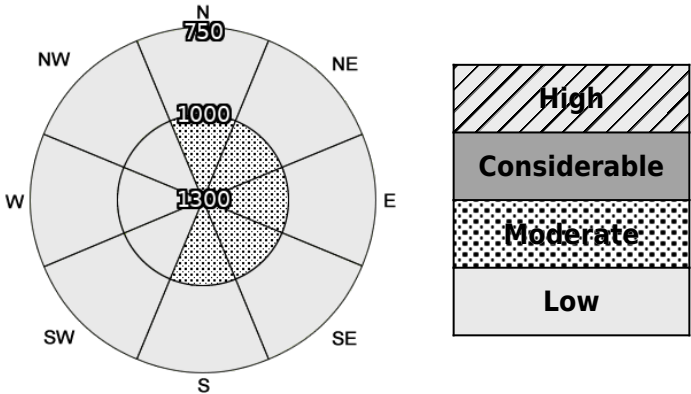

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all altitudes. Some wet snow instabilities will persist within deeper accumulations on steep and convex Northerly through Easterly to Southerly aspects above 1000 metres. On these aspects cornices will be unstable and threaten to trigger slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Storm force West-South-West winds will ease to gale force from dawn onwards. Light rain overnight will clear during the early hours. Dry with sunny spells during the day. The freezing level will remain above the summits.

Comments

Rock and ice fall a potential hazard during these mild damp conditions.
