

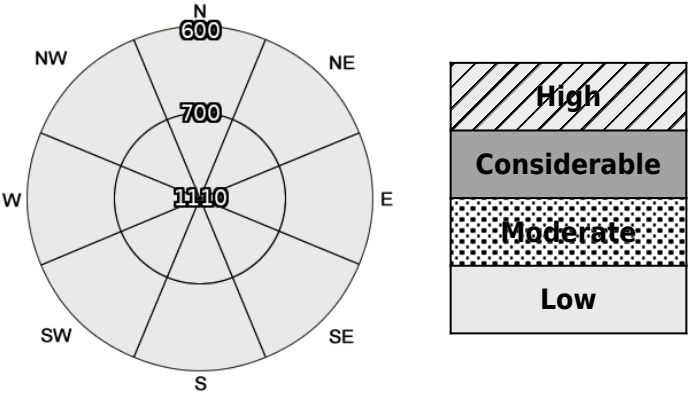

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 14/12/2024

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing shallow snow cover will remain well consolidated and stable in all locations. Fresh snow deposits overnight above 600 metres are not expected to be significant. Minor wet snow surface instabilities possible on some steep slopes as precipitation turns to rain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow above 600 metres overnight will clear to give a drier cloudy morning with rain developing at all levels during the afternoon. Moderate mainly Westerly winds will strengthen and back South-Westerly as the freezing level rises above the summits in the afternoon.

Comments

Existing snow expected to remain firm in most locations.
