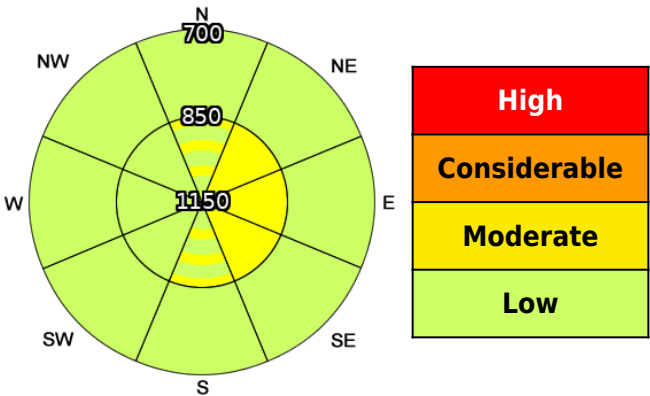
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab will be deposited throughout the period in wind sheltered areas, mainly on East to South aspects above 800 metres. This will fall almost entirely on bare ground. Accumulations gaining depth are not expected to be extensive, and will form mainly at the tops of gullies, around coire rims and along ridge flanks. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong mainly West-North-Westerly then North-Westerly. Showers are expected throughout the period falling as snow above around 400 metres. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.
