

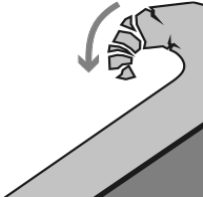

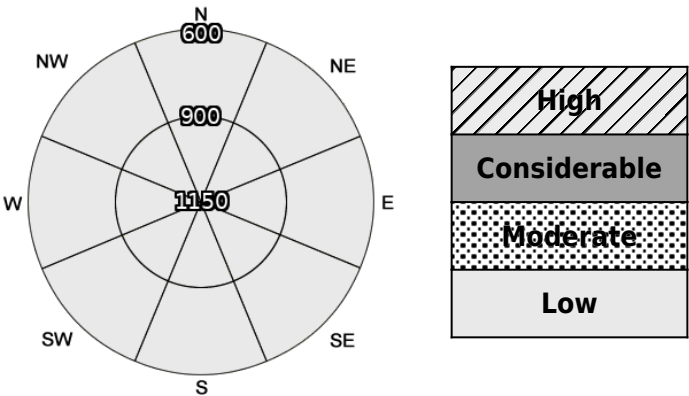

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New unstable windslab will develop in steep wind sheltered locations North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. These areas are expected to be isolated with gully tops and corrie rims most affected. Elsewhere, any wind exposed terrain will be scoured, older snow will be very firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

As the freezing levels drop precipitation will turn to snow by morning above 600 metres. Winds will be storm force during the day, West-South-West or West.

Comments

Saturday likely to be a difficult day on the hill. Storm force winds and snow showers forecasted.
