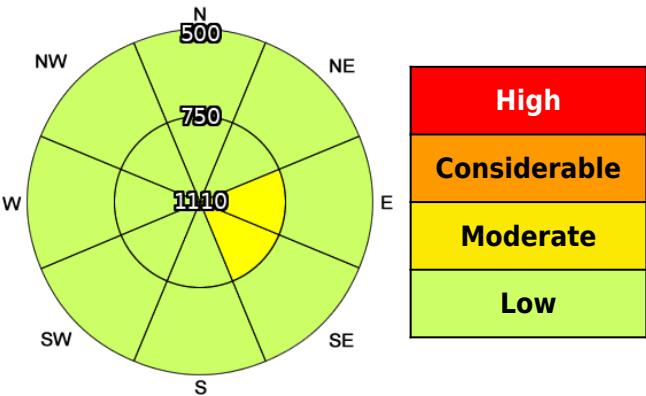
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Through the afternoon, localised areas of unstable windslab will build in steep wind sheltered locations, on East to South-East aspects, largely above 750 metres. Terrain most affected will be tops of gullies, coire rims and ridge flanks. Elsewhere, by the end of the day, there will be a shallow covering of new snow above 500 metres, overlying bare ground. High windward terrain will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain will ease by daybreak, followed by significant snowfall through the afternoon. South-Westerly gales overnight will gradually moderate through the day, veering West-North-West by mid afternoon. The freezing level will rise well above the summits overnight, lowering to 550 metres by the end of the period.

Comments

Significant snow accumulations forecast through Monday also.
