

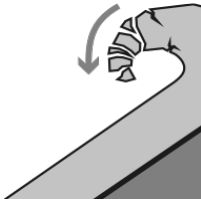

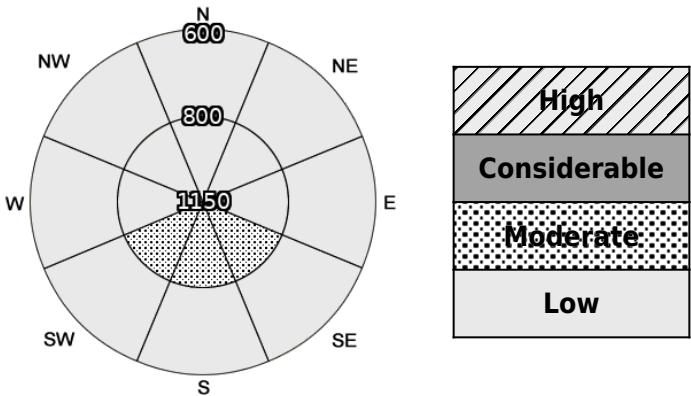
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will rapidly form in wind sheltered locations on mainly South-East, South and South-West aspects above 800 metres with some cross-loading expected. Deepest accumulations will form in the North of the forecast area. Drifts will also develop at lower elevations. Fragile cornices will form. Areas exposed to the wind will remain scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall throughout the period with greatest amounts falling in the North of the forecast area. Northerly winds, reaching gale force by the end of the afternoon. 450 metre freezing level.
