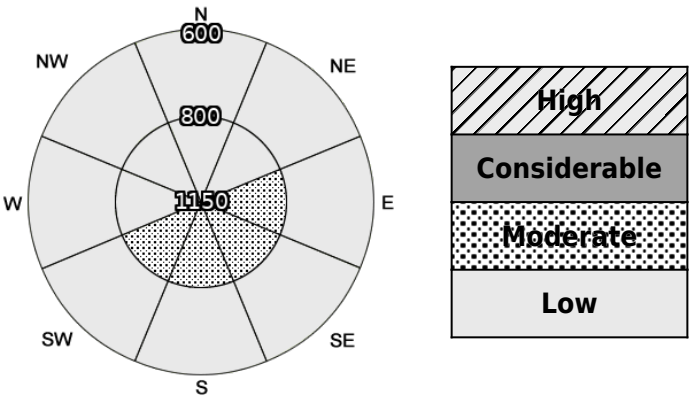
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of existing snow will continue the development of unstable windslab in wind sheltered locations on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. Deep drifts will also be encountered in any lee locations on other aspects and at lower elevations. Fragile cornices will continue to form. Areas exposed to the wind will remain scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold but very little new snow is expected. The North-Westerly winds will remain very strong overnight but ease during the day to become a strong breeze.

Comments

Drifts are becoming much deeper on tracks and footpaths making mountain travel hard work.
