

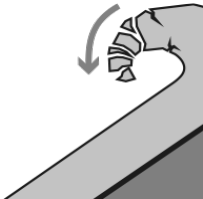

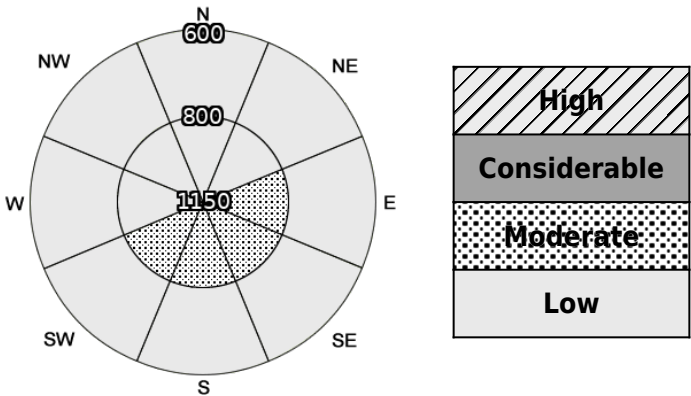
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered locations on East through South to South-West aspects above 800 metres. These areas will be localised and mostly avoidable. Elsewhere, very deep drifts will be present in lee locations. Wind exposed areas will be scoured and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with no new snow expected. Winds becoming strong around dawn, North-North-West throughout.

Comments

Very deep drifts, particularly sub 800 metres, very slow going. Snow expected around our Northern boundary, worth checking North Cairngorm report if heading that way.
