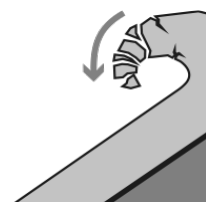
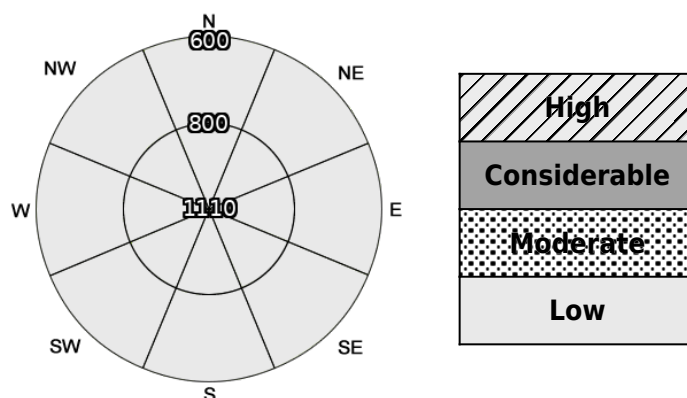


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 14/01/2025****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The thawing and generally patchy snowpack will continue to consolidate and remain stable and generally well bonded. Any remaining cornices, found mainly on East to Southerly aspects will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Largely dry overnight and through the morning. Light showers falling as rain all levels in the afternoon. Freezing level will remain well above the summits. Winds will be South-Westerly and ease slightly from Gale force, overnight, to Very Strong by Tuesday morning.

Comments

The wet snowpack will continue to diminish, with further significant snow loss expected over the coming days in the warm temperatures.
