

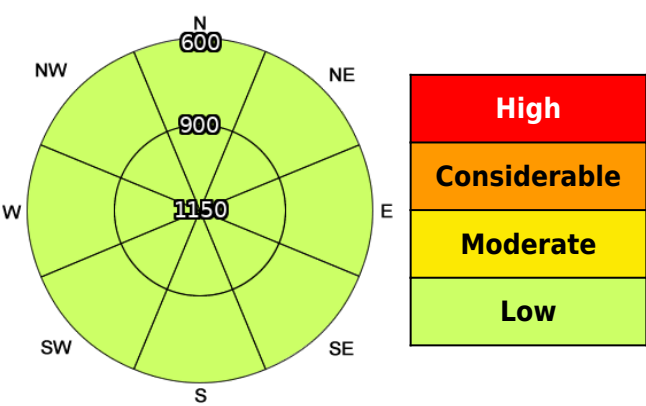

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/01/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The thawing and patchy snowpack will continue to consolidate and remain stable and generally well bonded. The greatest snow accumulations will be found on East through South to South-West aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will remain above the highest summits throughout the forecast period. Winds will be very strong South-Westerlies and no precipitation is expected.

Comments

The thaw continues, with the freezing level around 3000 metres. Snow cover now patchy, soft and wet throughout. There remains a possible hazard of falling ice and rocks from steep ground.
