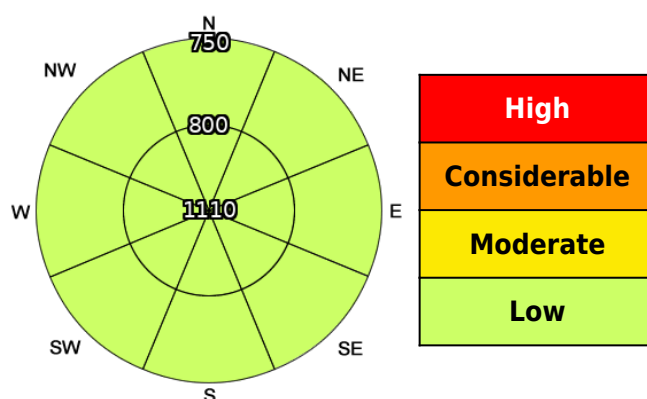


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 16/01/2025****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Remaining snow patches will be stable, generally well bonded and continue to thaw. The largest of these expanses will be found mainly on East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It is forecast to be largely dry but cloudy, through the day on Thursday, after some slight overnight rain. Freezing levels remaining well above the summits. Winds will remain Very Strong to Gale Force South-Westerly over the tops throughout the period.

Comments

It was far wetter this morning than forecast which has led to further depletion of the remaining snow patches. Not much change in sight for the Torridon area for the next couple of days with winds remaining Very Strong to Gale Force South-Westerly, and freezing levels well above the summits.
