

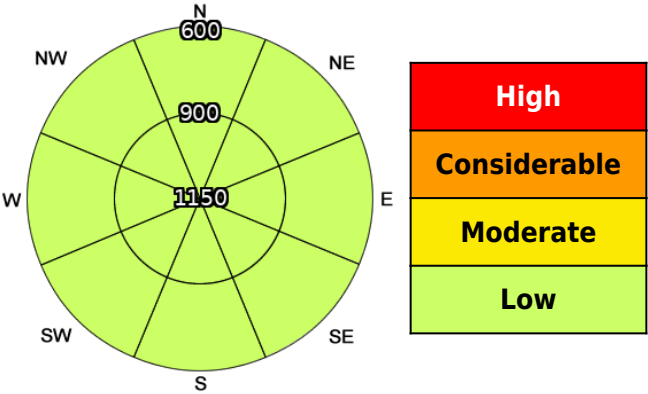

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Limited areas of well bonded snow may be encountered, mostly above 900 metres, mainly around corrie rims and in wind sheltered locations on some East aspects but more likely on South-East to South-West aspects. These conditions will be more prevalent in the high corries of the main Cairngorms. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day has been forecast with moderate to fresh South or South-Westerly winds. Slightly cooler conditions with the freezing level lowering to around 1000 metres for a time during the afternoon.

Comments

Little snow remaining. The high corries of Beinn a'Bhuird seem to be holding the most.
