

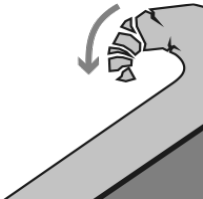

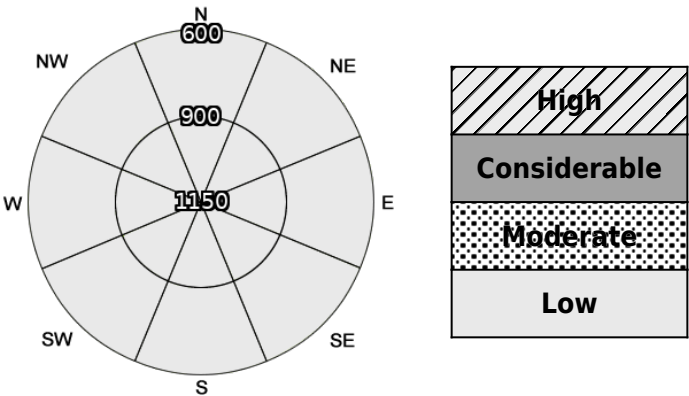
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will start to develop in the afternoon on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered areas such as gully tops and corrie rims will be most affected. Elsewhere, any wind exposed terrain will be scoured with older snow very firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a return to Wintery conditions. Freezing levels will be around 600 metres with snowfall forecast in the afternoon. Winds will be South-South-East, strengthening to gale force during the day.

Comments

Mountain weather conditions deteriorating with snowfall and gale force winds arriving over the area on Thursday afternoon.
