

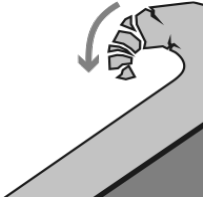

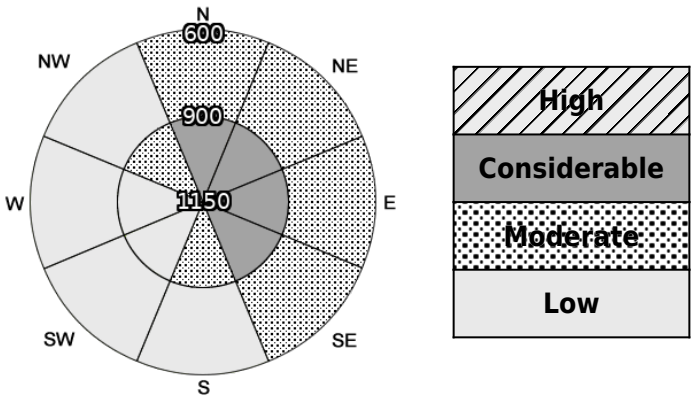

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Many areas will be wind scoured and stable. Moderately to weakly bonded windslab will be encountered in wind sheltered locations on North through North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres with shallower drifts also encountered below this altitude. Gully tops, corrie rims and steep burn lines will be most affected. Fragile cornices will be present on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very light snow showers overnight followed by a mainly dry day. Strong, generally Southerly winds overnight will ease slightly during the day, before becoming strong to near gale force East-South-Easterly winds from mid-afternoon. The freezing level will fluctuate around 450 metres throughout the period.

Comments

Mixed conditions underfoot - wind scoured slopes, deep drifts and icy crusts all encountered.
