

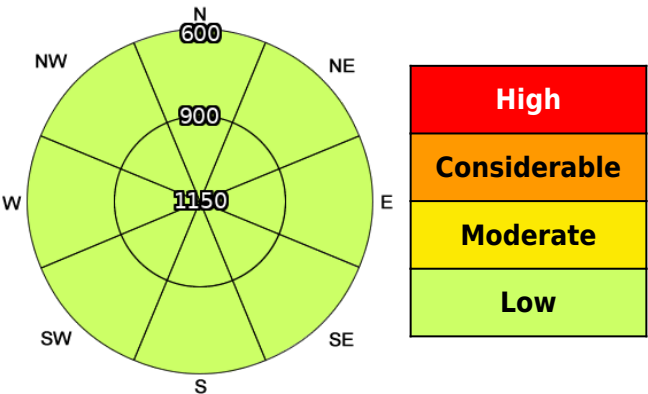

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. Isolated areas of windslab will be present around corrie rims and gully exits on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Older patchy snow will remain firm and well bonded throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry bright day is expected. The freezing level will be around 900 metres. There will be a strong breeze from the South-South-West backing to the South in the afternoon.

Comments

Snow is generally firm and icy, slips and trips will have serious consequences.
